Call ups

- Call ups will be allowed all season AND in the playoffs.
- Call ups can only be used when less than 2 subs will be available for a game.
i.e. for U12-20 divisions, a max # 13 players will be allowed to playing, including all call ups.
- Call ups must be identified on the game sheet.
- If regular team players show up late, call ups must be off the field and leave the bench area.
- Call ups allowed from younger teams, same sex, same club.

Games

- Winning teams MUST have game scores reported within a week or the team will receive a loss!!!
- Score reporting will be done online to “Home Town Sports” web site. It will be programmed so that game reporting will only be accepted during the week in question. Convenors and coaches will be given the necessary web site passwords and/or keys in order for this to be done.
- Each club can access their own info and all three clubs can network on game schedules, standings and pre-printed Game Sheets. Teams must use these game sheets as they will always have the same roster.
- The Paris Web site will still be available for standings and other info.
- Canceled games due to inclement weather will be automatically re-scheduled to the Friday of the following week. Same time, same field unless otherwise specified.
- Coaches, it is advised to inform your players that they are not to assume a game is canceled just because it is raining. Unless players receive a call, they're to assume the game is on. When in doubt, go to the game and make sure of its status. If a team can't field enough players and the game hasn't been officially canceled, then that team will lose by default.
- Games cannot be canceled for just any reason. It is the coaching staff's responsibility to make sure they're informed of players not being able to make it to a game. Therefore, players and parents must also assume that same responsibility and work with the coaches. Extenuating circumstances, such as a region wide school function is one example where a game could be canceled!
- When a team has fewer players than the usual # of players normally allowed on the field, then the opposing team will play with the same # of players plus one. *I.e. Team “A” has only 9 players (for 11 on field), then Team “B” must play with 10 on the field.*
- Players will sit on players' side of field, parents and other spectators sit on other side of field. No spectators/parents allowed behind the nets.
